

APPRENTICESHIP SCHOLARSHIP MODEL

Jumpstart your career in early childhood education with the Vermont Early Childhood Apprenticeship Program! VTAEYC and the VT Department of Labor collaborate via T.E.A.C.H. to help early childhood educators gain education and experience in the field.

WHO IS ELIGIBLE

Any early childhood educator who is currently working at least 30 hours/week in a regulated child care program or Agency of Education Setting (with a qualified mentor available on site). Applicants must have the ability to enroll as a CCV student and have the support of their employer to share the cost of the scholarship.

BENEFITS & COMMITMENTS

Recipients are awarded funding for 80% of tuition and 90% of books, a stipend to cover the costs of accessing classes each semester, a \$400 bonus, and counseling and administrative support for the program. In return, they must meet their portion of costs, earn the required credits, and commit to one more year at their sponsoring program. Employers are partially reimbursed for the recipient's paid time off and provided administrative support.




